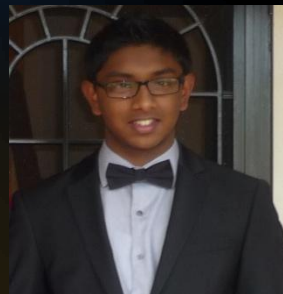

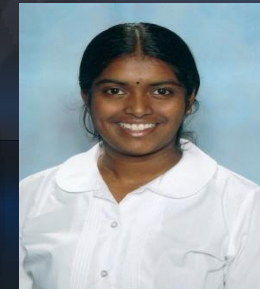

FUTURE PROJECTS

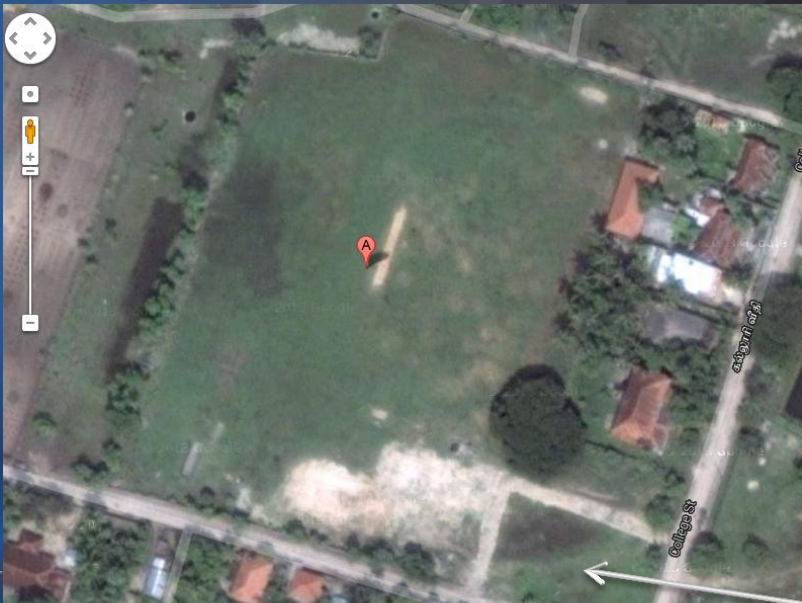
- to improve conditions of sports facilities at Hartley College (thanks for HCPPA NSW volunteers)
