

Annual Awards Programme

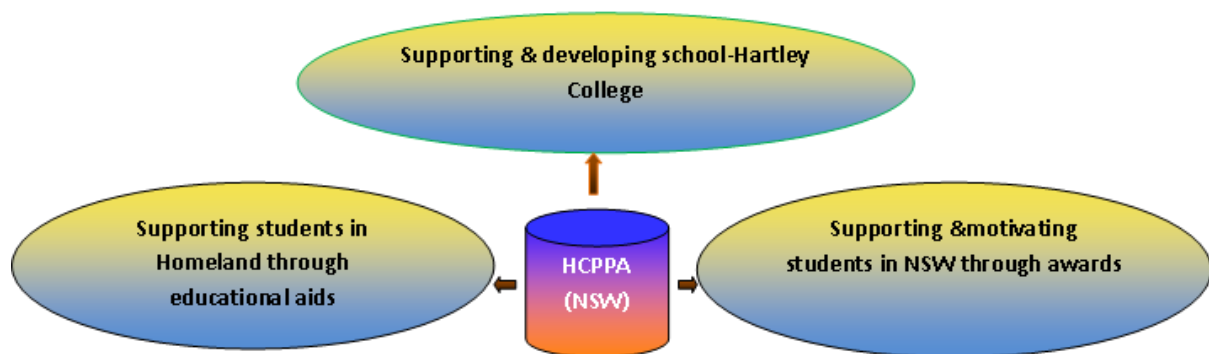

Award category:

Best Tamil Students of the Year

This award is presented to a Year 12 Tamil student, who has achieved the highest ATAR score

Selection process:

The selection in each category will be based on awards selection criteria and determined by the award sub- committee. Award subcommittee shall be nominated from the executive committee each year.

Winners of the Awards will be required to attend the annual KALAIZH CHUWEI program in September every year (award ceremony) in order to receive the award.

Award Selection criteria:**Best Tamil Student:**

- a. Tamil student, who has achieved the highest performance in year 12.
- b. Obtained the highest ATAR Score in NSW (as well as other applicable study scores).

Nomination

Nominations are welcome from wider Tamil community in NSW. A request for nomination will be sent around every year with an appropriate closing date for application.

Documentation and details required for nomination:

- a. Student statement of claim which lists all subjects undertaken
- b. ATAR Score (Year 12), as well as other study scores (as applicable)
